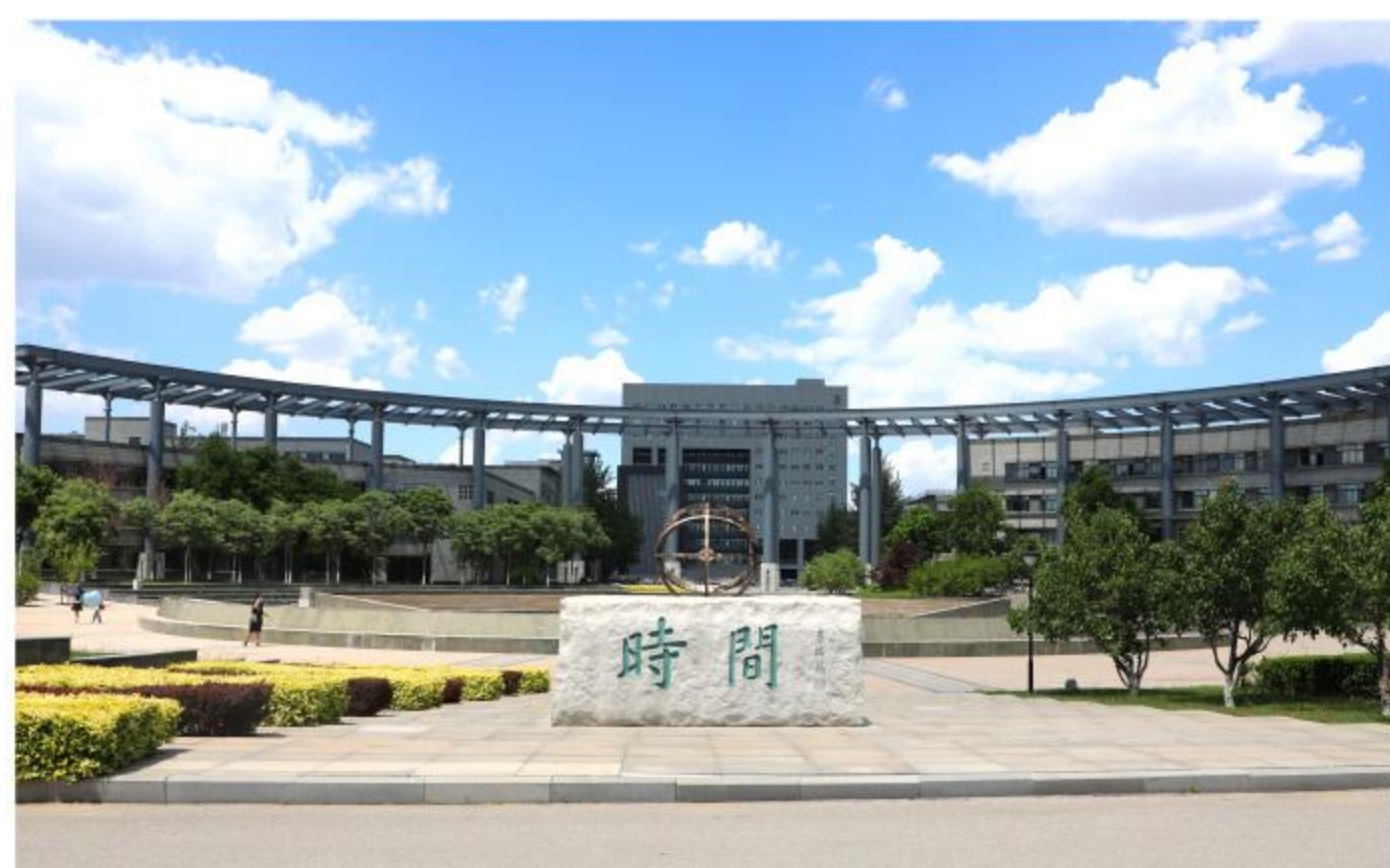
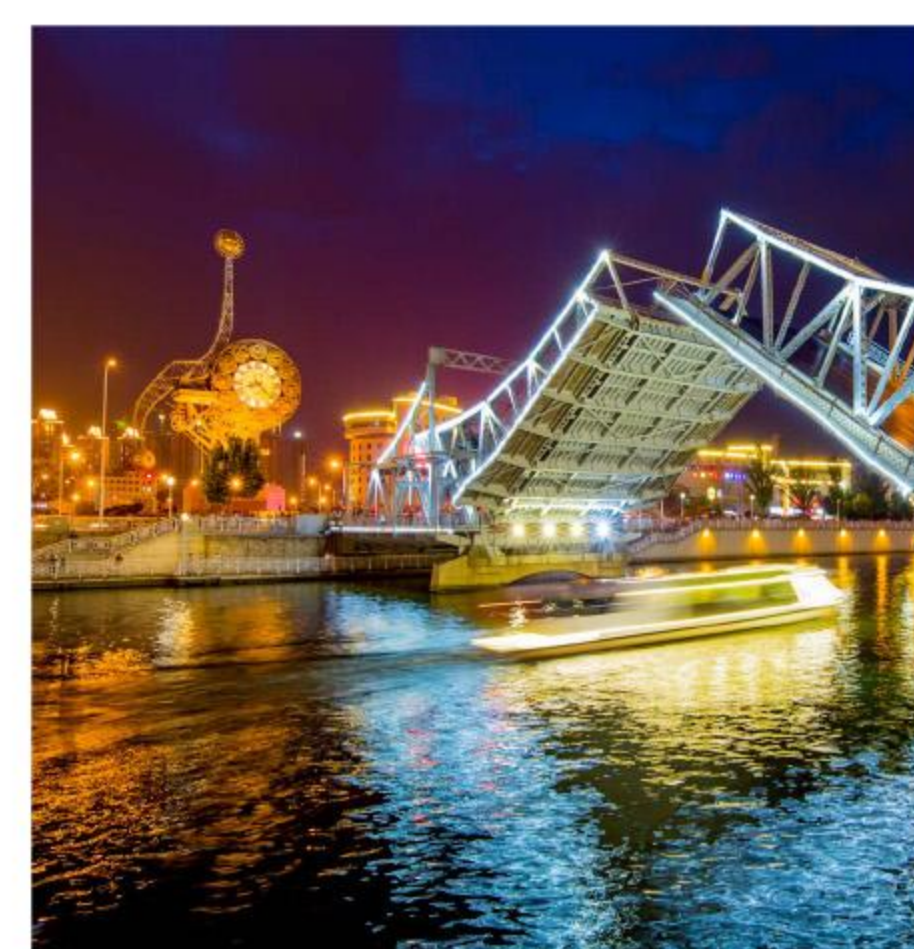
TIANJIN NORMAL UNIVERSITY

Tianjin is one of the four municipalities directly under the central government of China, along with Beijing, Shanghai, and Chongqing. It is located only 137 kilometers away from Beijing and can be reached by high-speed rail in just 28 minutes. Tianjin is a renowned international port city and eco-city that boasts both the grandeur of Huangyaguan Great Wall and the modern skyline of a bustling metropolis. Its unique urban landscape seamlessly blends Chinese and Western cultures, ancient and modern. Over the past century, Tianjin has undergone many changes, creating a unique cityscape that combines traditional Chinese and modern Western styles.

The school boasts beautiful natural environment and unique ecological style, with lakes and wetlands surrounding the teaching area, where students can immerse themselves in lush greenery and the sight of fish and birds, and the fragrance of flowers. The university has two faculties and 20 colleges, with more than 30,000 full-time Chinese and international students. By far, it has established partnerships with 190 universities, institutions, and local governments from 35 countries and regions. It is also a designated recipient university for Chinese Government Scholarships, International Chinese Language Teacher Scholarships, and Tianjin Government Scholarships for foreign students. Currently, international students from more than 50 countries are studying at TNU and enjoying the diverse environment.

Professor Zhong Yinghua, Dean of Institute for the Development of International Chinese Language Education Co-Founded by Ministry of Education and Tianjin Normal University is academic leader of International Chinese Language Education TNU's international education focuses on practical teaching, aims to create a better life for students, and makes every efforts to meet students' demand. In 2023, Center of International Chinese Education of Bei-jing-Tianjin-Hebei Region, with a total area of more than 33,000 square meters, will provide more advanced teaching facilities for international students and further promote the internationalization of the university.

1. The fee covers registration, accommodation, tuition, cultural exploration (optional), but does not include airfare, insurance fee, food, visa, bank charges and other miscellaneous expenses.

3. Students can dine at the on-campus cafeteria, with an estimated cost of 30-50 yuan per person per day.
